### **ADL on the Frontline**

Features news, events, feature stories, public opinion polls, book reviews on racism and anti-Semitism. This magazine is published monthly except for July and August by the Anti-Defamation League of B'nai B'rith.

### **Amerasia Journal**

Published by the Asian American Studies Center at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) three times a year, this journal features in-depth articles, essays, and perspectives on Asian American history, social issues, immigration, and politics.

### **American Indian Culture and Research Journal**

This multidisciplinary journal for both scholars and the general public started publication in 1971 and is published quarterly by the American Indian Studies Center at UCLA. Scholarly papers, book reviews and literature are provided on sociology, anthropology, and education topics.

### **American Journal of Sociology**

Established in 1895, this prestigious publication provides articles on analysis and research in the social sciences. Published by the University of Chicago Press bimonthly, an online index to all issues since its inception is available at <http://www.journals.uchicago.edu/loi/ajs>.

### **Colorlines Magazine**

Published bi-monthly, this magazine is devoted to stories and news about race and politics.

### **Ethnic and Racial Studies**

Published bimonthly by Routledge, this periodical offers analysis of social and political issues of race and ethnic relations throughout the world.
